**Every Friday in Lent is a day of ABSTINENCE**

**Abstinence** from meat is observed on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all the Friday's in Lent by all Catholics 14 years or older. **Fasting** is observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 60. Those bound by this rule may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted as necessary to maintain strength according to one's own needs, but eating solid foods before meals is not permitted.

The judgment which will be passed on each one of us immediately after death is called the particular judgment.

**If everyone is judged immediately after death, why will there be a general judgment?**

Although everyone is judged immediately after death, it is fitting that there be a general judgment in order that justice, wisdom, and mercy of God may be glorified in the presence of all.

The general judgment is not really a new trial, but a judgment, that is, a public declaration and manifestation of the sentences or rewards already given or made in the particular judgment.
