Every Friday in Lent is a day of ABSTINENCE
Abstinence from meat is observed on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all the Friday's in Lent by all Catholics 14 years or older.
Fasting is observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 60. Those bound by this rule may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted as necessary to maintain strength according to one's own needs, but eating solid foods before meals is not permitted.

No COMMUNION OF REPARATION - April 3rd and 4th
There will be NO Communion of Reparation in April due to Good Friday and Holy Saturday. Our Communion of Reparation will resume in May 2015.

No EUCHARISTIC MONTHLY ADORATION - April 2nd, 2015
There will be NO Eucharistic Monthly Adoration on April 2nd due to Holy Thursday. We will have Adoration on Holy Thursday after the Mass until 12:00 Midnight.

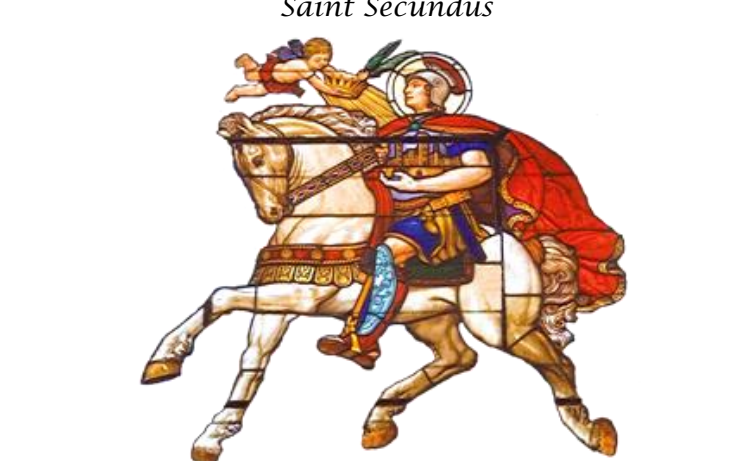
Good Friday "Way of the Cross" at Planned Parenthood, Pomona
