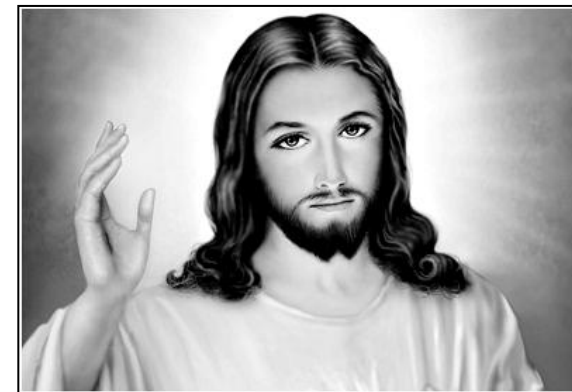
FAMILY MOVIE NIGHT - MOVED TO APRIL 18th
