Jesus gave His Mother to us as our mother also. Dying on the Cross, Jesus told Saint John, standing there with *His* Blessed Mother, “Behold Thy Mother!” Throughout more than twenty centuries our Catholic Church joyfully accepted Mary from Jesus, as, one of His most precious gift.

One of the invocations in the Litany of the Blessed Mother speaks of her as **“cause of our joy.”** And indeed she is. She gave us Jesus who is our Savior.
