**THE MOST HOLY TRINITY**

**May 31st, 2015**

**O God...**

What a joy should it not be to us men, with what hope and love should it not inspire us, to know that in our own very land, in our own churches, quite near our own homes, the true God, the Holy of Holies, is really living and present in the Blessed Sacrament of the Altar! That God whose very presence makes the Saints in Heaven happy! That God who is Love itself! St. Bernard tells us that it is not so much that God loves us or gives the gift of love, as that He is actually Love itself. So the Blessed Sacrament is not merely a sign indicating love, but is Love itself, because It is God Himself, who, on account of the very great love He has for us whom He has created, calls Himself, and really is Love itself: ***God is Love (Charity). (1 John 4:16).***

But I hear You complaining, O my Sacramental Jesus, that You came on earth to be our guest, to help us and do good for us, and that we have not made You welcome. *I was a stranger, and you took me not in. (Matt. 25:43).* You are right, O Lord: it is quite true. And I am among the ungrateful ones who have left You all alone and have not even come to visit You. Punish me as You please, but do not deprive me of Your presence, which is the punishment I deserve. I wish to make up to You for the rude and discourteous way I have treated You. For the future, not only will I visit You often, but I will stay with You for as long as I can. O most merciful Savior, grant that I may be faithful to You and that my example may inspire others to keep You company in the Blessed Sacrament. I hear the Eternal Father say: ***This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased. (Matt. 8:2).***

If God finds in You a source of happiness for Himself, shall not I, too, who am only a worthless creature of His, find my happiness in this valley of tears in living with You? O consuming fire of love, destroy in my heart every attachment to things created, for they only can make me unfaithful to You; they only can separate us. You have the power to destroy the attachments if You wish; *Lord, if Thou wilt, thou canst make me clean. (Matt. 8:2).* You have already done so much for me; do this too. Drive from my heart every love that is not in keeping with Your love. I give myself entirely to You. This very day I dedicate all that remains of my life to loving the Blessed Sacrament. O my Sacramental Jesus, it is You Who must be my comfort. You must be the one for me to love during life and in the hour of death, when, I trust, You will come to be my Food and Guide for my journey to Your holy kingdom. That is my hope. Oh, may it be so!
