I regret to inform you that SB 128, Doctor Prescribed Suicide, just passed a full Senate vote, 23 yes to 14 no. The bill will now continue to the State Assembly, where we will work to stop it as it works its way through various committees. If SB 128 passes through these committees it will be voted on in the full State Assembly, if it passes the Assembly, Doctor Prescribed Suicide, will become legal in California. Before that we have a lot of advocacy to do.
