**Like Little Children**  
“Unless you become...”

There may be rare exceptions, but most children, because of their innate virtues, are easily loved. They are free from pretense, innate virtues and trustful of others. They are vibrant, happy and innocent. Jesus knew the need we grownups would have at times to recapture the characteristics of childhood.

How often we fall short of a child’s tolerance that forgives...! How often we lack a child’s readiness to wonder, a child’s courage to try again and again to acquire a new skill, his/her indiscriminate love that hates no one and carries no unhappy hang-ups to the next day.

The day that Jesus set a little child in the midst of His Apostles and said to them, “Unless you become as little children you shall not enter the Kingdom of Heaven,” He gave a needed object lesson to us all.
