**STATIONS OF THE CROSS - EVERY FRIDAY EXCEPT GOOD FRIDAY**

We will have Stations of the Cross *inside the church* at 6:00 PM every Friday of Lent beginning on February 12th.

**Every Friday in Lent is a day of ABSTINENCE**

**Abstinence** from meat is observed on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all the Friday's in Lent by all Catholics 14 years or older.

**Fasting** is observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 60. Those bound by this rule may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted as necessary to maintain strength according to one's own needs, but eating solid foods before meals is not permitted.

**40 Days for Life: Feb. 10th - March 20th**

*A baby was saved on Ash Wednesday in Pomona! A woman left Planned Parenthood and told one of our prayer warriors, "What you are doing is not in vain." God is so good to us!*

Abortion hurts women and kills babies. The Alan Guttmacher Institute reports that **one out of three American women** will have an abortion by the age of 45. The British Journal of Psychiatry reports that women who have had one or more abortions have an 81% increased risk of having mental health problems. **More than 50 million** babies have been aborted in the USA since 1973. When people pray and/or counsel outside abortion centers, hearts are changed and lives are saved, and some souls can be spared the tragedy of abortion.
