ASH WEDNESDAY SCHEDULE - Feb. 10th

Our Ash Wednesday Schedule is as follows: 6:30 AM and 8:00 AM Novus Ordo (English). The Latin Mass will be held at 7:00 PM. Ashes will only be given out after the Masses. Ash Wednesday is a **Fast and Abstinence** Day.

Abstinence from meat is observed on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all the Friday’s in Lent by all Catholics 14 years or older.

Fasting is observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 60. Those bound by this rule may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted as necessary to maintain strength according to one’s own needs, but eating solid foods before meals is not permitted.

We will have Stations of the Cross *inside the church* at 6:00 PM every Friday of Lent beginning on February 12th.
