Heroism

Love and sacrifice go together as with Elizabeth Pilenkoa, a young Russian who escaped Communism by fleeing to France. During the persecution of the Jews in World War II, she founded a convent as a haven for the Jews. When the Gestapo found her, she was led to the concentration camp at Ravensbruck. During the two and a half years she saw a block of buildings erected which were actually gas chambers, though the prisoners were told they were to be hot baths for prisoners.

One day a number of women prisoners were lined up before the building. One girl became hysterical. Mother Maria, for that was her name as a nun, was not among those selected. To the girl who became hysterical she said, “Don’t be frightened. I shall take your turn,” knowing very well she was going to her death. It was Good Friday when she died.

Every Friday in Lent is a day of ABSTINENCE

Abstinence from meat is observed on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all the Friday's in Lent by all Catholics 14 years or older.

Fasting is observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 60. Those bound by this rule may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted as necessary to maintain strength according to one's own needs, but eating solid foods before meals is not permitted.
