My Dear Parishioners,

We pray every first Friday in the Act of Reparation to the Sacred Heart, “we are determined to make amends for the manifold offenses against Christian modesty in unbecoming dress and behavior, for all the foul seductions laid to ensnare the feet of the innocent...” We have signs of acceptable attire; we have a modesty article in the bulletin every Sunday. In spite of all this there are not a few parishioners whose attire is immodest. Since the act of reparation quoted and the articles in the bulletin aren't specific. There are those who think that their dress is not against modesty. And so as a reminder: shorts, sleeveless tops, cleavage exposure, tight slacks on women, mini-skirts, bare midriffs, tight and sheer clothing (including leggings/nylons exposing knees) would all fit into this category of immodest fashions. Sadly, few priests warn their flock of the great danger associated with immodesty of dress, that of losing one's soul for all eternity. So many girls and young women are growing up today without direction and, like so many misled sheep, are following immoral fashions to the destruction of souls. Pope Pius XII said, “There always exists an absolute norm to be preserved no matter how broad and changeable the relative morals of styles may be.” These words mean that there are absolute “unchangeable” standards.

Summer, unfortunately, brings with it the height of immodesty, in most men and women. This is a good time then to remember the words of Our Lady of Fatima who warned us that: more souls go to hell for sins of the flesh (i.e. sins against the 6th and 9th Commandments) than for any other reason.” Our Lady of Fatima told Jacinta, “Certain fashions will be introduced that will offend my Son very much.” Jacinta also said, “People who serve God should not follow fashions. The Church has no fashions; Our Lord is always the same.”

My dear ones, when it comes to writing these letters, I am tempted to say “enough.” The parishioners are tired of getting letter after letter. Then I think, who would be more pleased with me not writing anymore, God or Satan? At my particular judgment I will have much to answer for. May my silence in this matter not be an additional cause for punishment. All of you have filled my heart with joyful gratitude. I know that I should have been a much better pastor. God has blessed me so much in my priesthood, certainly not the least of which is you. Please pray that I will obey Him completely through our Blessed Mother. God bless you and thank you.
