REMINDER: In the Novus Ordo Liturgy, you may receive Holy Communion on the tongue or the hand, and you may kneel or stand. We must always approach our God with reverence and thanksgiving for His redemption. If you receive Holy Communion in the hand, you must remember that it is not appropriate to reach out and take the host. You extend your arm and open your hand with the other hand underneath supporting it. So also when you receive on the tongue, the communicant responds with Amen, and opens his mouth and extends his tongue. We also must help the priest not to lose even the smallest particle of the Blessed Host. Thank you. -- Father Louis
