Catholic Custom of Parental Blessing

"Years ago", a priest relates, "When I was traveling, I do not remember the date, but it was on a Sunday afternoon. The sun was shining brightly in the valley. Presently I came--I was walking--to a house by the roadside, and in front of the house was a woman with a young child. The woman sat on a low stool; before her stood the little one; still somewhat feeble on its feet.

"After playing a while with its mother's face and hair, the little one, suddenly laid its left hand on its mother's head and with the right hand made the sign of the cross on her brow.

The child blessed the mother!
How came this infant to do such a thing?

How often must the mother have blessed the child in the quiet hours of the day, morning and evening, at table, in play, until the little one remembered exactly and now did the same thing to its mother!"

The Parents Blessing is Far Reaching

The parent's blessing has always been considered most honorable. An old proverb says that the parents' blessing is followed by good fortune in every way.

In the book of Sirach we read: "Honor thy father that his blessing may come upon you and abide you forever."

And again: "A father's blessing builds houses for his children, a mother's curse destroys them."

The great St. Ambrose says: "Whoever is blessed by his parents is blessed by God."

Perhaps it might be a wise practice, and if it is not a family practice to make it so, to send your children to school with a blessing. These days, many terrible things seem to happen, in and around schools. Many parents have said after tragedy has struck, and a child is no longer with them. "I never had a chance to say, 'I love you'."

Having given The Parental Blessing you will have the comfort of knowing that they will be receiving that gift of God's Love---eternally, that your parental blessing constantly requests for them.

Children too, should be in the habit of asking for your blessing upon them. This strengthens the family bond and again is greatly needed in this age.
