**COVENANT EYES**

Covenant Eyes is an online accountability service for individuals and families. For children, parents can block specific internet sites or block all sites, opening only the sites they would allow their children to visit. Parents can block out certain times and limit the days and times their children can get onto the internet. Parent receive daily or weekly email reports giving detailed review of what sites their children have visited, the YouTube videos they have watched and the search terms they have used. For adults, individuals can pair up with a partner to be accountable to for his/her internet viewing. The accountability partner would have access to the email reports for the internet user as explained above.
