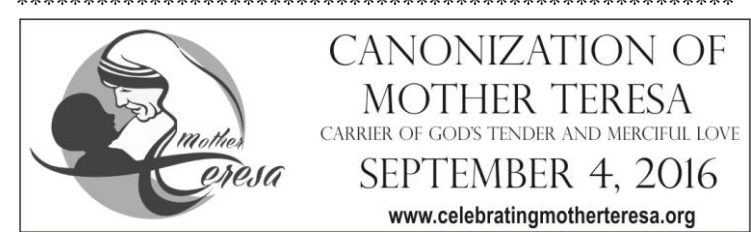
**FORMED FEATURE FOR SEPTEMBER: MOTHER TERESA**
