P: (Genuflect) And dwelt among us.

Pr: Pray for us O Holy Mother of God.

P: That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ. **Pr:** Let us Pray

All: Pour forth, we beseech Thee, O Lord, Thy grace into our hearts; that we to whom the Incarnation of Christ Thy Son was made known by the message of an angel, may by His Passion and Cross, be brought to the glory of His Resurrection. Through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.

REGINA COELI

All: Queen of Heaven rejoice, Alleluia. For He whom thou didst merit to bear, Alleluia. Hath risen as He said, Alleluia. Pray for us God, Alleluia.

Priest: Rejoice and be glad, O Virgin Mary! Alleluia!

People: Because the Lord is truly risen. Alleluia.

Priest: Let us pray.

All: O God, who by the resurrection of Thy Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, granted joy to the whole world: grant, we beg You, that through the intercession of the Virgin Mary, His Mother, we may lay hold to the joys of eternal Life. Through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.

ACT OF CONTRITION

I firmly resolve, with the help of Thy grace, to sin no more and to avoid the near occasions of sin. Amen.

PRAYER AFTER COMMUNION

Jesus, My Lord and my God, I believe that Thou art truly present within me, Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity. Increase my faith in this great mystery. I adore Thee and I love Thee with my whole heart, my King and changeless Friend. I thank Thee for the many graces Thou hast given to me, and in particular for coming to me in Holy Communion. I am not worthy to receive thee. Please help me to become more worthy. Give me the strength to do Thy Holy Will and to see Thee in everyone I meet. Bless my friends, relatives, and parishioners, the Holy Father and all priests and religious. Have mercy on all sinners and the souls in Purgatory. Lead all souls to heaven. Mary, My Dearest Mother, and you, O St. Joseph pray to Jesus for me. Amen.

PRAYER AFTER MASS

(Say one Hail Holy Queen and three, Hail Mary’s)
Jesus, My Lord and My God, our refuge and our strength, look down in mercy on Thy People who cry to Thee; and by the intercession of the glorious and immaculate Virgin Mary Mother of God, of St. Joseph, her spouse, of Thy blessed apostles, Peter and Paul, and of all the saints, in mercy and goodness hear our prayers for the conversion of sinners, and for the liberty and exaltation of our Holy Mother the Church. Through the same Christ our Lord, Amen.

MEMORARE

Remember O most Gracious Virgin Mary, that never was it known that anyone who fled to thy protection, implored thy help or sought thy intercession was left unaided. Inspired by this confidence, I fly unto thee, O Virgin of virgins, my Mother. To thee do I come, before thee I stand sinful and sorrowful. O Mother of the word Incarnate, despise not my petitions, but in thy mercy hear and answer me. Amen.

HOLY NAME SOCIETY PLEDGE

Blessed be God.

Blessed be His Holy Name.

Blessed be Jesus Christ, True God and True Man.

A MORNING OFFERING

CHAPLET OF DIVINE MERCY

(On the rosary beads)

(Say one Our Father, Hail Mary and Creed)

(Say at each large bead)

“Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and the sins of the whole world.”

(On the 10 small beads of each decade say)

“For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.”

(Concluding doxology) (After five decades)

(Say three times)

“Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.”
